

Will you be a visiting student this summer?

Courses for the Kentucky Foster Care Census are only being offered through the University of Kentucky, Eastern Kentucky University and Western Kentucky University. If you are currently enrolled in a different college or university you can still be a census taker, but you have to apply to be a visiting student at one of these schools for the summer. The only exception is for graduate students at the University of Louisville who can enroll in SW 698.

To apply to be a visiting student you have to:

- Submit a regular undergraduate admissions application by the deadline. These forms are available on-line and at the PCWCP Retreat.
- Include a letter of good standing or an official transcript from your university.
- You do not have to pay the admissions fee of \$25-30. Include the note on the bottom of this page in your application and the admissions fee will be billed to the Census.
- Notify Heidi Hiemstra at 502-564-7130 or Heidi.Hiemstra@mail.state.ky.us of the school you have applied to by the admissions deadline. In order to pay for your admission fee we have to know that you have applied.

The deadlines to apply to be a visiting student are:

University of Kentucky	April 15 for Summer I May 15 for Summer II
Eastern Kentucky University	May 1
Western Kentucky University	May 1
